**A RESOLUTION FOR SPEED LIMIT DECLARATION OF COUNTY ROAD
131 REESE ROAD (SOUTH OF US30)**

WHEREAS, Title 31, Chapter 5 Article 3 of the Wyoming Statutes establishes the speed regulations on all public roadways in Wyoming. Effective July 1, 2011 the speed limit on County Road 131 Reese Road (South of US30) was established at 65 mph unless engineering and safety criteria establish a different speed limit.

WHEREAS, Wyoming Statute 31-5-303 authorizes local authorities to establish specific maximum speed limits within their respective jurisdiction.

WHEREAS, In June 2024 Inberg-Miller Engineers, and Laramie County conducted a speed study on the paved portion of County Road 131 Reese Road (South of US30). This speed study analyzed the paved roadway in one section. This section is: mile post 0.0 to 0.5.

WHEREAS, the speed study conducted concluded that the speed limit from mile post 0.0 to 0.5 be raised from the posted 45 mph to 50 mph. These are all consistent with Wyoming Statute 31-5-303(e).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF LARAMIE COUNTY, WYOMING, as follows:

Laramie County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the County Public Works Department post County Road 131 Reese Road (South of US30) with the new speed limit of 50 mph.

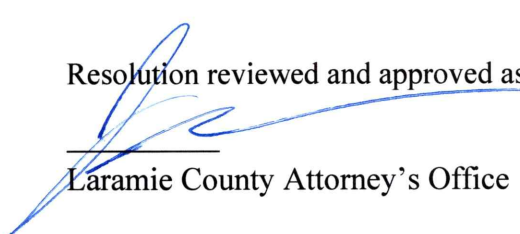
