- **A.** To appropriate unanticipated Homeland Security Grant revenues of \$ 213,351for:
 - 1) \$ 38,985 Laramie County Sheriff's Department equipment (Fund 221)
 - 2) \$ 6,168 Laramie County Coroner supplies and equipment (Fund 221)
 - 3) \$168,198 County EMA supplies and equipment (Fund 221)
- B. To appropriate unanticipated State Business Ready Grant revenues of \$ 540,000: (Fund 242)
 - 1) \$500,000 Creekside Homes Partnership –Infrastructure
 - 2) \$ 40,000 Home Ownership Program
- C. To appropriate unanticipated City of Cheyenne overtime reimburse revenues of \$ 20,000 for deputies working for the "Cheyenne Area Gang Enforcement Unit". (Fund 101)
- D. To appropriate unanticipated HHS Grant revenues of \$26,734 to purchase elections equipment. (Fund 101)
- E. To appropriate unanticipated State Homeland Security grant revenues of \$ 1,800 and matching money from fund balance of \$451 for a total of \$2,251 to be used for a hazardous waste disposal. (Fund 207)
- F. To transfer and appropriate \$500,000 from General Fund (Fund 101) cash reserve to the Juvenile Services Center Fund (Fund 241) to allow for the hire and training of employees.
