WHEREAS, the Laramie County Board of Commissioners is eligible to apply for and receive 2022/2023 SHSP funds and;

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of Laramie County desires to participate in the Wyoming Office of Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSP) by sponsoring this grant application to assist in financing this project; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of Laramie County has been provided with preliminary cost estimates and information on this project; and


