THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LARAMIE COUNTY, WYOMING declares the week of April 10 through 16, 2022, to be National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week in Laramie County, in honor of the men and women whose diligence and professionalism keep our city and citizens safe.
