Cate Cundall, Planning, said Steil Surveying Services, LLC, on behalf of Maria Chavez, dba Little Rascals Daycare, submitted a zone change application for Tract 1, Hermann Meadows Subdivision, Laramie County, WY, located at 314 E Jefferson Rd. The application was submitted for a zone change from Medium Density Residential (MR) to Mixed Use (MU) to allow for expansion of the daycare facility. A site plan application was submitted concurrently but placed on hold to allow for reconfiguration of the building design to accommodate 60 children. The original site plan was based on 100 - 150 children.

Ms. Cundall said based on evidence provided, staff recommends approval of the zone change with the adoption of findings of fact a, b and c.
