**"RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE RETROCESSION OF FEDERAL JURISDICTION
OVER APPROXIMATELY 75 ACRES OF PROPERTY HELD BY THE UNITED
STATES AIR FORCE IN LARAMIE COUNTY WYOMING"**

WHEREAS, the Department of the Air Force has proposed the retrocession of federal jurisdiction over approximately 75 acres of federal property located in Laramie County Wyoming, in accord with 10 U.S.C.A § 2683; and

WHEREAS, the Department of the Air Force has identified said property as a prime location for private development under the United States military's "Enhanced Use Lease" program involving non-excess property pursuant to 10 U.S.C.A § 2667; and

WHEREAS, under the Enhanced Use Lease program, underutilized property can be leased to a private developer who will then construct facilities for the government as well as private commercial development on the property; and

WHEREAS, it is proposed by the Department of the Air Force that said property be changed from its current exclusive federal jurisdiction to concurrent federal state jurisdiction and the property shall be provided police and other municipal services by the City of Cheyenne and Laramie County;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF LARAMIE COUNTY, WYOMING, that it supports the United States Department of the Air Force's proposal to retrocede federal jurisdiction over approximately 75 acres of property located in Laramie County Wyoming.
