Response to Application Question: Interest in Serving on the Board

I am writing to express my interest in serving on the Laramie County Community Juvenile Services Joint Powers Board. I bring to this opportunity nearly two decades of leadership experience in Laramie County School District #1, where I have served as an assistant principal, principal, Assistant Director of Instruction, and currently, as the Director of School Leadership.

For the past eight years, I have had the privilege of supervising educational services at the Laramie County Juvenile Services Center (JSC). This work has involved close collaboration with the educators stationed at the JSC, as well as with the Laramie County Sheriff's Department, to ensure that students in custody continue to receive a high-quality education.

In addition to my work with the JSC, I oversee the district's Title I, Part D program, which focuses on prevention and intervention for children and youth who are neglected, delinquent, or at risk. Through this grant, we have implemented a number of impactful programs, including the hiring of a Court-Ordered, Neglect and Delinquent Transition Consultant, enhanced transition services for students involved in the court system, dropout prevention initiatives, student progress monitoring procedures, and improved access to wraparound services for students and families.

My responsibilities as the district's federal grants director have also included oversight of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Program, Title III (English Learners), and Title IV (Student Support and Academic Enrichment). These programs have allowed me to support at-risk students through the work of dedicated professionals such as our Parent Engagement Facilitators, Safe and Healthy Schools Assistant, Workforce Partnership Facilitator, MTSS Coordinator, and ESL Coordinator.

Over the years, I have collaborated with numerous community organizations serving at-risk, neglected, and delinquent youth, including Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA), Guardian Ad Litem (GAL), the Division of Family Services (DFS), the Boys and Girls Club, the After School for Kids (ASK) program, and STARBASE.

Given my experience in education, program oversight, and community collaboration, I believe I can offer valuable insights and contribute meaningfully to the mission of the Laramie County Community Juvenile Services Joint Powers Board. I am committed to supporting our youth and ensuring systems are in place to promote their long-term success.
