The Laramie County Sheriff's Office currently utilizes ballistic shields that are rated NIJ IIIA, which means they are rated to stop bullets fired from handguns. However, these shields DO NOT provide any ballistic protection for deputies from bullets that are fired from rifles. Currently, there is an apparent upward trend in the use of rifles during active shooter events. Deputies responding to these types of incidents are at a severe disadvantage in terms of protection from a rifle-armed threat, as the current shields provide no protection, and only the deputy's chest area is protected from rifle fire. This leaves their head/arms/abdominal area exposed to devastating injury from rifle fire. Time is of the essence in stopping an active shooter event, and deputies will be unable to end the threat to others if they become casualties themselves. We are requesting the purchase of four ballistic shields that are rated for rifles. Two would be dedicated to patrol operations and two of the shields would be dedicated for SWAT Operations.

Our THIRA identified On-scene security, protection and law enforcement as an area that we need to continue to build and sustain. Our office wants to continue to ensure a safe and secure environment for both law enforcement officers and citizens. In addition to active shooter events, Laramie County deputies operate in a county that has a large rural population, where the possession of rifles is a normal and expected occurrence. The terrain deputies operate in is often open, providing little or no cover when dealing with situations like suicidal subjects, domestic disturbances, and burglaries. Rifle-rated ballistic shields will provide a much higher level of protection to deputies when operating in open terrain and with suspects likely armed with rifles. This request will help to sustain on scene security, protection and law enforcement capabilities as addressed in the THIRA by providing deputies with the protection they need.

15. All projects under this grant must have a nexus to terrorism. Please describe how your project relates to acts of terrorism.

The Laramie County Sheriff's Office/Cheyenne Police Department SWAT Team responds to active calls for assistance. Often times these situations are geared towards protecting the community from violent offenders or responding to turbulent situations involving deadly weapons. In these situations ballistic shield's have been proven to assist law enforcement officers in emergency response for more efficient scene security. With the increase of domestic terrorism over the years, having this equipment has become essential to the safety of our officers and citizens alike.

The requested rifle rated ballistic shields require little to no maintenance. Laramie County will assume all responsibility for the sustainment of the requested equipment in partnership with the joint SWAT Team. All equipment will be inspected on a regular basis and will be available for immediate use.

The Cheyenne Police Department/Laramie County Sheriff's Office Joint SWAT Team does not have any rifle-rated ballistic shields. The SWAT team primarily deals with barricaded suspects who are suspected of committing violent felonies. As with deputies, SWAT operators do not have any ballistic protection from rifle bullets other than their chest armor. Additionally, many rifle-rated ballistic shields are extremely heavy, requiring them to be mounted to a wheeled platform, which severely limits their mobility, especially when operating on uneven terrain and within structures. The requested shields are designed to be light enough that they can be carried by an

individual.
