





Margaret Augusta Stevenson Loshbaugh, was born in Cheyenne, Wyoming on July 12, 1910, the second child of Sterling Price Stevenson and Dollie Pagett Stevenson who were married in Cheyenne in 1906. Her brothers, Sterling Stevenson and Clarence Stevenson are both deceased. Her older sister, Roberta Louise, died at the age of 13.

She lived in Huntington Park, California from 1920 to 1926. She attended the old Corlett School in Cheyenne and graduated from the old Central High School in 1928. She married her childhood sweetheart, Oren Leslie Loshbaugh, in 1933 in Kimball, Nebraska. His parents drove them to Kimball and they returned to her new in-laws home to live. They are the parents of five children. Roberta Louise Lucas (deceased in 1985), Bruce Loshbaugh of Cheyenne, David Loshbaugh of Aurora, Colorado, Carolyn Loshbaugh of Denver, Colorado and James Loshbaugh (deceased 2005). The three eldest were born in Cheyenne and the two youngest were born in Washington State where they lived during World War II. They returned to Cheyenne in 1952, living in her current home since 1953. Mr. Loshbaugh died in 1985, they were married for 52 years.

Mrs. Loshbaugh is a member of the Mizpah Chapter of #36 Order of Eastern Star, joining in 1930. She has belonged to Magic City Lodge #5, 100F since 1929, and is a past Noble Grand. For over thirty years she has been a member of the Women's Club and has headed the Arts group of the club during that time.

After his retirement, Mr. & Mrs. Loshbaugh traveled all over the western United States, towing their trailer. They were able to visit family and friends. Their tours took them to majestic locations no longer accessible to motor vehicles. One of her favorite locations is Death Valley, CA, in the spring. She loves the flowers and fauna of the desert. They are charter members of the local chapter of the Good Sam Club and were active members until 1985.

Mrs. Loshbaugh has seen Cheyenne grow and grow to it's present size. Her extended family contributed to the growth of Cheyenne with a barbershop, Justice of the Peace, Post electrician at Warren Air Base, Stevenson Electric Company, building contractor and carpenter. Mrs. Loshbaugh is Cheyenne's living history.

Today her extended family lives in primarily in California, Oregon, Washington, Texas, and Colorado. She is the grandmother to 15 grandchildren and step-
