**RESOLUTION OF LARAMIE COUNTY’S INTENT TO ADOPT
THE LARAMIE COUNTY FAIR RULES**

WHEREAS, Wyoming State Statutes, § 18-5-201 authorize Laramie County, in promoting the public health, safety, morals and general welfare of the county. To regulate the use of land through zoning in unincorporated Laramie County; and

WHEREAS, Wyo. State. Ann. § 18-9-101, authorizes the board of county commissioners to acquire land for fairgrounds, to maintain and operate fairs and exhibitions, and to perform such other acts necessary to carry out the provisions of this section; and

WHEREAS, Laramie County desires to host the Laramie County Fair in the unincorporated area of Laramie County and to regulate the fair through the Laramie County Fair Rules; and

WHEREAS, Wyo. Stat. Ann. § 16-3-103, requires 45 days public notice and a reasonable opportunity for public comment before Laramie County may adopt, amend, or repeal rules and regulations;

WHEREA, the proposed Laramie County Fair Rules are attached hereto as “Exhibit 1” and incorporated into this resolution by this reference;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF LARAMIE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, that notice is hereby given to the public that the Laramie County Government intends to adopt the Laramie County Fair Rules as attached; that copies of the proposed Laramie County Fair Rules may be obtained from Laramie County Clerk’s Office 309 W 20th St., Cheyenne, WY 82001 on the Laramie County website at <https://laramiecounty.legistar.com/Calendar.aspx> ; that all interested persons may submit written comments to the Laramie County Clerk’s Office 309 W 20th St., Cheyenne, WY 82001, no later than 3:00 p.m. on April 3rd , 2026; that there shall be a public hearing of the Laramie County Commissioners on the proposed Laramie County Fair Rules on April 7, 2026 at 3:30 p.m. at 310 West 19th Street, Suite 310, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82001


