“RESOLUTION RESCINDING STAGE 1 FIRE RESTRICTONS FOR LARAMIE COUNTY AS A RESULT OF EXTREME FIRE DANGER”

WHEREAS, pursuant to W.S. § 35-9-301 through 35-9-305 the Laramie County Board of County Commissioners has the power to order the imposition of restrictions on or prohibit designated activities within the confines of Laramie County in order to limit the use of fire or fire hazard;

WHEREAS, Laramie County, Wyoming was experiencing abnormal fuel loads as a result of below average seasonal moisture, and in combination with above normal seasonal temperatures and low relative humidity, the fire danger was high to extreme;

WHEREAS, the Laramie County Board of Commissioners passed Resolution # 260317-12 enacting Stage 1 Fire Restrictions effective March 18, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Laramie County Fire Warden has advised the Laramie County Board of Commissioners that the conditions justifying Stage 1 Fire Restrictions for Laramie County to forms of fire and fire hazards have now abated;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF LARAMIE COUNTY, WYOMING, that the Stage 1 Fire Restrictions for Laramie County to forms of fire and fire hazards imposed March 17, 2026, resolution # 260317-12, pursuant to W.S. § 35-9-301 and Chapter 9 of the Rules and Regulations of the State of Wyoming Board of Land Commissioners is now and shall be rescinded.


