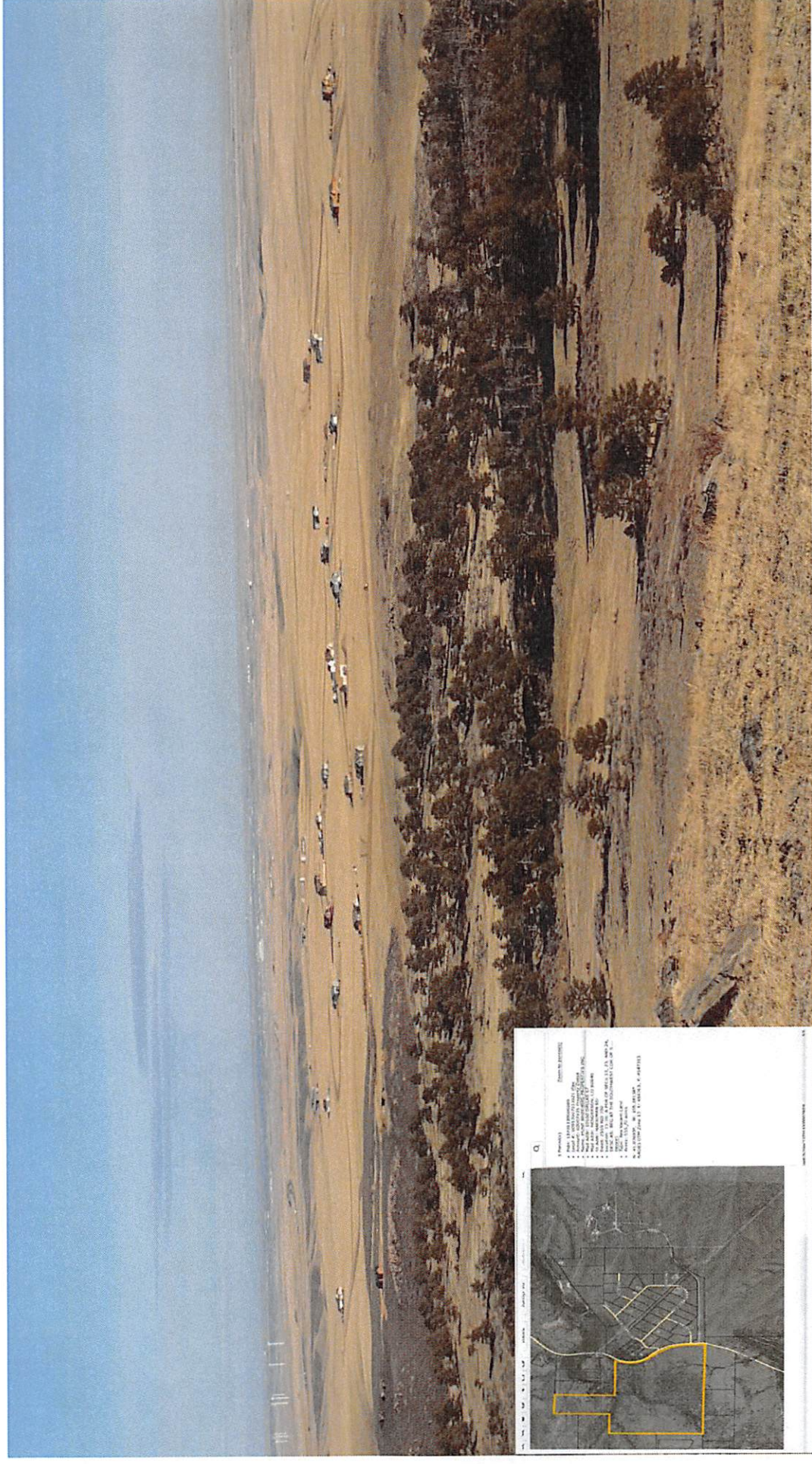

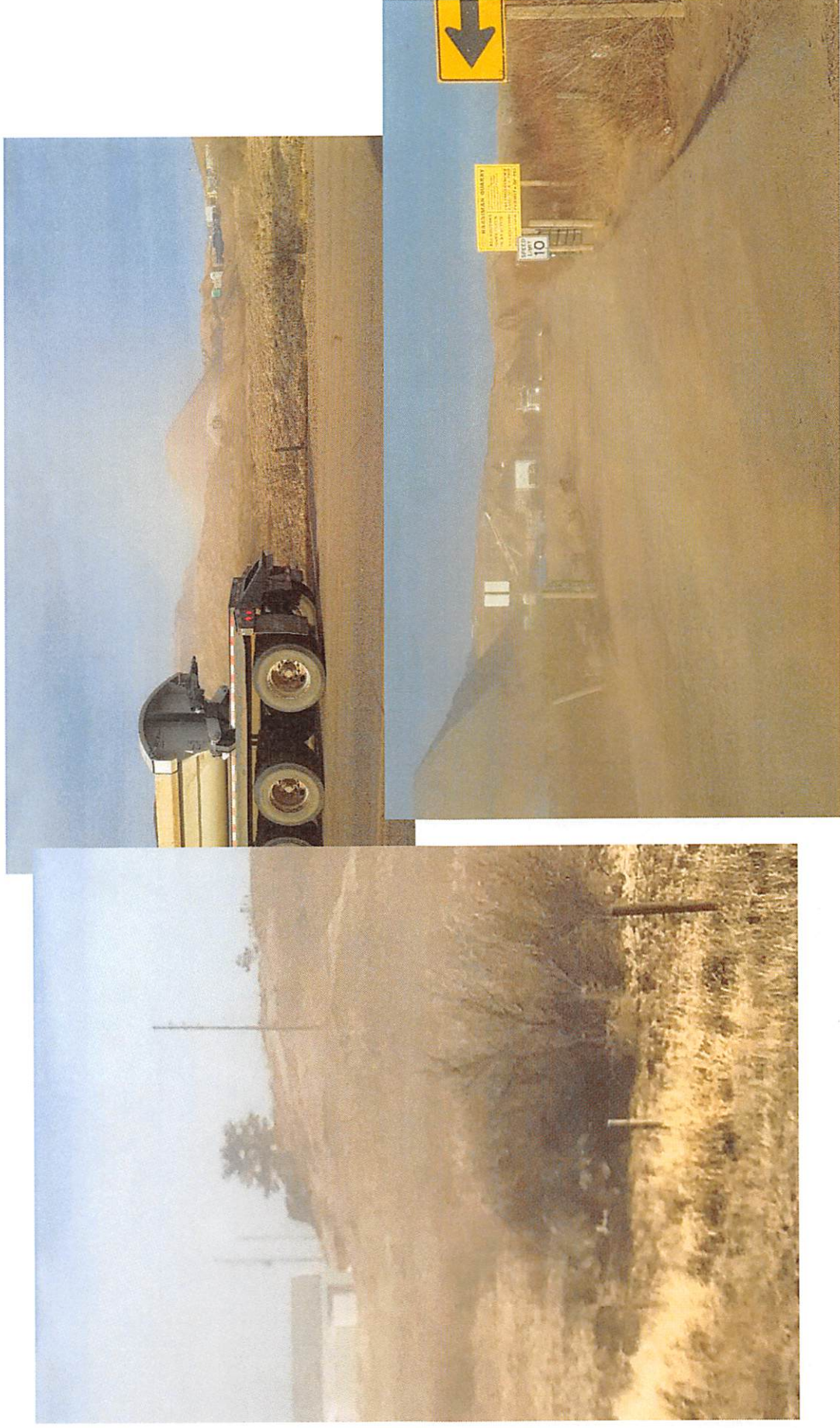

Proposed Quarry Site Concerns

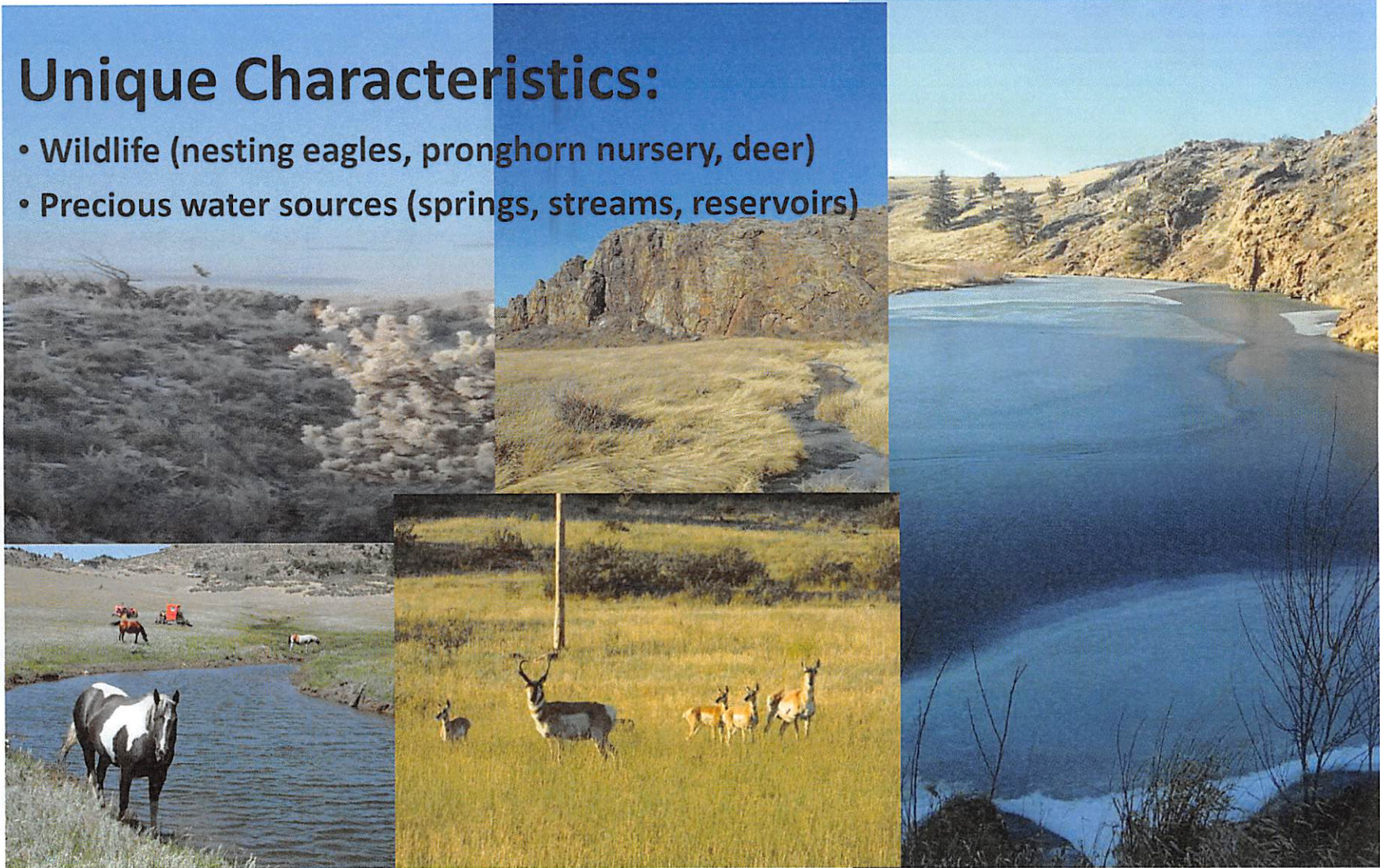


Picture of dust coming off of a small quarry on Harriman Road to the north of Interstate 80.
