The Shooting Sports Complex received a SLIB Consensus award in the amount of \$80,000 towards this project CWC-13163 La. At that time we competitively bid out the project and selected Action Target. The bid came in over budget and we have been working to secure additional funds prior to moving forward.

The Shooting Sports Complex was opened in the summer of 2012 with 14 interior lanes. This project will alter the spacing of the lanes/stalls and add an additional 5 lanes while replacing the manual targets with an automated system. The manual lanes while fully functional, present difficulties with controlling and handling the targets for a certain portion of the population. The project will provide the indoor range with a total of 19 lanes with at least one stall being fully ADA accessible. The Shooting Sports Complex serves the people of Laramie County as well as visitors from outside the county and state. The project will make it easier for the population of Laramie County to fully utilize the facility regardless of any individual accessibility needs.

The total estimated project cost is \$136,400. Of that we hope to utilize the remaining SLIB Consensus balances in BFY11/12, BFY13/14 and BFY15/16 for the Laramie County Portion. After this is fully allocated we will be short \$7,155 which will come out of local funding in order to complete the project.

All preliminary design plans and work has been completed along with the competitive bid process. If the additional grant funds are awarded we will move forward in working with Action Target to negotiate an agreement and begin working during the fall of 2015.
