A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 251216-6 TO REDUCE THE AMOUNT REQUESTED FROM THE WYOMING SUPREME COURT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2027 AND 2028 WYOMING COURT SUPERVISED TREATMENT PROGRAM GRANT FROM \$628,583.52 TO \$601,279.60.

THE GOVERNING BODY OF LARAMIE COUNTY, WYOMING RESOLVES;

To submit an amended grant application to the Wyoming Supreme Court for the FY2027 and FY2028 Wyoming Court Supervised Treatment Program Grant in the amount of \$601,279.60, reducing the previously authorized request of \$628,583.52, to fund operations and programs of the Laramie County DUI Court;

and,

To commit \$78,000 in matching funds to be included in the Laramie County's FY2027 and \$78,000 in matching funds in the Laramie County's FY2028 budgets, both amounts which remain unchanged;

and,

To Appoint Sandra Newland, or her successor in the position of the Laramie County Grants Manager, as agent and grant contact for Laramie County to execute and submit applications, financial reports and certifications which may be necessary for this application and grant;

and,

To authorize Fernando Muzquiz, or his successor in the position of the Director of the Laramie County Treatment Courts Office, to implement programs funded by this grant and to make programmatic and performance reports relating to this grant on behalf of the Laramie County Board of Commissioners.
