Dear Laramie County Commission,

When I first entered Memorial Hospital of Laramie County (MHLC) as a graduate nurse in May 1973, little did I know the impact the organization would have on my career over the next four decades. After working on all but two of the hospital units as a staff nurse, I realized my passion for the continuum of care and quality improvement. Developing and overseeing a viable quality program involving both the physician and clinical staffs was by far my most gratifying accomplishment. Through this experience, I was able to develop useful skills including collaboration, cooperation, team building, organization and time management.

As the Director of Quality Improvement, I directly interacted with the MHLC [and eventually United Medical Center (UMC)] Board of Trustees. At that time, the Board members were primarily from the business sector. Improving their understanding of clinical care issues and concerns was truly a challenging and rewarding experience. I collaborated with the Board President to increase his understanding of clinical monitoring activities occurring within the hospital in accordance with JCAHO requirements. We were eventually able to extend these efforts to other Board members resulting in increased awareness of the Board's role in hospital quality initiatives.

Throughout my career, I was awarded nursing opportunities external to the hospital that advanced my knowledge of the healthcare industry. Working at the University of Wyoming, United Blood Services, Mountain-Pacific Quality Health Foundation, Internal Medicine Group and WinHealth Partners enhanced my awareness of regulatory and reimbursement aspects of healthcare and other clinical/technical settings.

I've enjoyed eighteen months of retirement after working nearly 44 years as a registered nurse. Taking time to contemplate and reflect on the importance MHLC/UMC/Cheyenne Regional Medical Center(CRMC) has had on my life, I find this opportunity to be considered for a position on the CRMC Board of Trustees tremendously revitalizing. My robust understanding of healthcare will benefit the current board members and the people served by Cheyenne Regional Medical Center.
