15. PUBLIC HEARING regarding board approval for a telecommunications tower located at Tract 10, Sunset Tracts, 3rd Filing, Laramie County, WY.

Michael Surface, Planning, said SSC submitted an application for a telecommunications tower located on Sunset Tracts, 3rd Filing Tract 10. Glory Evangelical Lutheran Church, property owner, will enter into a lease if the Board approves the application.

Charmaine Dregalla, the applicant, explained her company represents Dish, which is a new wireless carrier. The 100 ft tower would fill a gap in coverage.

Mr. Surface said based on evidence provided, staff recommends approval of the telecommunications tower with the adoption of findings of fact a and b.

Acting Chairman Lovett opened the hearing for PUBLIC COMMENT. Bob McCue, resident, spoke against approval of the request. He said incorrect and insufficient information was sent to landowners in the area. Hearing no further PUBLIC COMMENT, Commissioner Lovett closed the hearing.

Commissioner Lovett questioned County Attorney Mark Voss about the legalities of the notice. Mr. Voss requested time to review land use regulations before providing an opinion.

Mr. Surface gave the chain of events for the notice. Two notices were sent to landowners, the first notice--with incorrect information--was sent by certified mail and a corrected notice by first-class mail.

A motion was made by Commissioner Malm, seconded by Commissioner Holmes, to postpone this item for 45 days and ask the applicant and Planning Dept to properly re-notice all affected properties by certified mail within 30 days, revisiting this item in 45 days after the proper notification has been made.
