- **01** Commissioner Holmes moved to approve the Minutes of Proceedings for April 21, 2015. Commissioner Kailey seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
- **02** Commissioner Thompson moved to approve warrants in the amount of \$2,610,363.10 for April 2015. Commissioner Heath seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. Documentation is filed in central files with the County Clerk.
- O3 Commissioner Thompson moved to approve the following part-time salaries in the amount of \$27,597.25 for April, 2015: Planning, \$570.00; Shooting Sports Center, \$3,652.71; Buildings/Grounds, \$13,352.88; Sheriff Operations, \$1,630.00; Detention Operations, \$7,092.06; Coroner, \$1,300.00. Commissioner Heath seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
- O4 Commissioner Thompson moved to approve the following fees collected by various County entities for March 2105: Shooting Sports Complex, \$20,682.10; DUI Court, \$425.00; Drug Court, \$837.00; Circuit Court, \$53,699.00; Planning & Development Office, \$129,641.62; County Clerk, \$149,914.84; Sheriff's Department, \$169,026.73; Clerk of District Court, \$17,312.75. Commissioner Heath seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. Documentation is filed in central files with the County Clerk.

Commissioner Heath seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. After obtaining all signatures, the contract is to be filed in central files with the County Clerk.
- 10 Commissioner Thompson moved to approve a contract between Laramie County and Wyoming Department of Health to provide substance abuse treatment services as a sentencing alternative in accordance with the Court Supervised Treatment Act (W.S.S. 7-13-1601 7-13-1605) all current State Rules & Regulations, and policies and procedures established by the Wyoming Department of Health in the amount of \$215,157.48 to run July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2015. Commissioner Heath seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. After obtaining all signatures, the contract is to be filed in central files with the County Clerk.
- 11 Commissioner Thompson moved to approve a Catering Permit for the Hair Ball to be held May 29th located at 312 South Greeley Highway. Commissioner Heath seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. Documentation is filed in central files with the County Clerk.
