

The Laramie County Consumer Fireworks Retail Sales Regulations (CFRS) provide that the Board of Laramie County Commissioners may place reasonable restrictions or standards upon the issuance of a Laramie County Fireworks Sales Permits. Further, the CFRS provides that violation of such restrictions or standards may result in revocation of any issued permit. This permit is conditioned upon compliance with the existing Laramie County Consumer Fireworks Retail Sales regulations as well as any applicable law or regulation, state, local or federal and the following restrictions and standards:

**Condition One:** Mr. Frank Elliott shall not be present, or within 300 yards (travel along 1-25 excluded), of the location of each respective fireworks permit, to wit:

- 201 Interstate 25 Frontage Rd, Building A, Cheyenne, WY 82007

The conditions apply for the duration of each respective seasonal or annual permit as indicated below:

- 201 Interstate 25 Frontage Rd, Buildings A: Seasonal permit

For the duration of each respective seasonal or annual permit

**Condition Two:** Violation of Condition One as applicant agrees and it is hereby ordered, shall be the basis for revocation of all permits referenced herein. Upon evidence of a violation of Condition One, and/or of the LCFR sufficient to warrant revocation, notice and hearing will be provided pursuant to LCFR, 2.8.3.3.1 to the applicant of the intent of the County to revoke the issued permits herein. This shall afford the applicant a chance to appear before the Board of County Commissioners, if so desired, to oppose revocation. After a hearing, should the Board determine to revoke, all permits granted in this resolution shall be forfeit immediately, and the retails sales halted, pursuant to 2.8.3.3.2 LCFR.
