Question **Date Required: 8/23/2018**

During the demolition phase of second floor, we discovered that all of the normal 120v and 277v branch home run conduits are run in the slab. Further more, there are branch circuits connecting to existing receptacles which are shown to remain. All of the boxes where these circuits run to were in demoed walls and do not line up to the new floor plan layout. Branch circuit home runs will most likely need to be re-routed from the electrical panel(s) they originate from.

We have already began to remove wiring to receptacles which are shown to remain so conduits can be cut flush with the floor and allow interior framing to begin.

Branch panels all have existing conduits coming out of the top and bottom of the panels not allowing for much room to add all new branch conduits according to current code standards.

1. Recommended Solution

Install new overhead conduit rack from the electrical panels on 2nd floor to the scope areas to re-distribute the branch home runs. Intercept the branch circuits routed into the top of the panel into a gutter or j-box above the panel and re-route into the panel via new larger conduit and wire also allowing the installation of the new branch conduits from overhead,
