


**Items Requested:** We are requesting lights and sirens for an existing vehicle. The equipment will include a new siren and speaker, Mpower lights in push bumper, SpectraLux lights for under the visors, Microplus Wide angle lights for the side mirrors, and Micropulse Ultra 1200 to be installed on the back bumper to prevent people from hitting the rear of the vehicle while it is stopped at a scene. All equipment will be affixed and installed within the vehicle. Breakdown on cost is below.

**Cost Per Item and Total:** Federal, SmartSiren Platinum 2000, 100w, programmable siren/light controller w/noise cancelling microphone and 11 solid state relays. Total of \$1,147.50. Federal Speaker and smart siren bracket \$319.50. Sound off signal Mpower grill light \$334.80. Spectralux ILS, low profile \$1,152.00. Additional equipment needed includes micropulse wide angle, micropulse ultra red and blue and installation costs \$3,717.60 for a grand total of \$6,671.40.

**Why Items are Needed:** This equipment will provide protection to the Coroner responding to scenes of fatalities or potential fatalities. Not only will the equipment keep them safe, but it is also an important safety measure for citizens and other first responders. The equipment will benefit the department for years to come and can be removed and re-installed if/when a new vehicle is purchased. The main purpose of our request is to provide lights and sirens to an emergency vehicle to make it audible and visible. This is necessary to draw attention and identification to the Coroner vehicle and clear the right of way for a fast and efficient response. The lights and sirens also protect the scene by making it highly identifiable to reduce collisions.

**Comments:** It is hard to truly quantitate the benefits and lifesaving properties of having appropriate lights and sirens on a vehicle. Recently (April 2019) the Coroner was responding to an accident involving one confirmed casualty and her lights on the vehicle were not working properly. As a result, people were not aware that she was a first responder and her response time was delayed. She was not able to get on scene in a quick and safe manner. Once on scene her vehicle was not properly recognized as a responder, which could have implications for scene safety.

The Laramie County Coroner's Office is under the umbrella of County budget and operations. Our budget has to be approved and adopted by the County Commissioners. The Commissioners are responsible for an entire county and often needs and priorities within our department are unable to be met by local county funding. The State of Wyoming has seen a significant decrease in tax revenue that is handed down to Counties and local Municipalities. This cut has impacted all emergency responders alike and non-critical or required programs and equipment are often times unfunded.
