The Election Management System (Electionware) used by Laramie County includes a hardened server. The server is utilized in the election office of the County Clerk, which is in an area where physical isolation of the equipment is not possible. The area has no interior doors. The area also houses a Ballot on Demand printer which enables the printing of official ballots. In order to ensure the physical security of this critical election equipment, Laramie County proposes installation of a security camera to record and capture movement in and around the area where the server and Ballot of Demand printer resides. Footage from the camera will be accessible to and monitored by the County Clerk/Chief deputy and ITD.

8. If your project involves cyber security improvements, please describe the project and how it mitigates cyber security risks for Wyoming's elections. Please provide plenty of detail specific to your office, county, and/or the state.

9. How will your project increase the capability or reduce vulnerabilities in protecting, preventing, responding, or recovering from an act of terrorism in relation to elections as critical infrastructure?

Project will mitigate the risk of unauthorized personnel attempting to access Electionware and the Ballot on Demand printer during periods of time when staff are not present in the area. Video surveillance will also ensure that authorized personnel follow official protocols on use of the equipment. The security camera will reduce vulnerabilities in physical security of the Election Office.
