Bryan Nicholas, Planning, said Black Hills Energy and Cheyenne Light, Fuel and Power, submitted a Wind Energy Site Plan application for the Corriedale Wind Energy System Project, located on the King Ranch property, approximately six miles west of Cheyenne. The application seeks approval for a Large Wind Energy System.

Mr. Nicholas said based on evidence provided, staff recommends approval with the adoption of findings of fact a with one condition: The applicant shall submit a supplementary document or revised site plan showing the routes of the proposed high power transmission lines prior to recordation of the resolution.

Chairman Heath opened the hearing for PUBLIC COMMENT. Clint Bassett, City of Cheyenne Board of Public Utilities (BOPU), said the applicant has been responsive in addressing the concerns of BOPU. Mark Eisele, owner and operator of King Ranch, expressed his support for the proposed project. Hearing no further PUBLIC COMMENT, Chairman Heath closed the public hearing.
