WHEREAS, the Governing Body of Laramie County desires to participate in the Wyoming Outdoor Recreation grant funding program by sponsoring this grant to assist in financing this project; and

WHEREAS, the Wyoming Office of Outdoor Recreation requires that certain criteria be met, as described in the federal and state rules governing the prevention program, and to the best of our knowledge this application meets those criteria; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of Laramie County has been provided with preliminary cost estimates and information on the project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF LARAMIE COUNTY that a grant application be submitted to the Wyoming Office of Outdoor Recreation in the amount of \$145,000.00 for consideration of funding a fitness court.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Sandra Newland, or her successor in the position of Laramie County Grants Manager, is appointed as agent of the Laramie County Board of Commissioners to execute and submit applications and certifications for these funds and to receive funds and implement the programs funded under this grant.
