Tania Riedel, applicant, said the lease approval has been completed, and she has been working on the site plan and is ready to proceed with Planning and Development.

John Ysebaert, representative of the Cheyenne Pass HOA; KJ Cullen, representative of Table Mountain Ranches Owners Association; Justin Hesser, counsel for Kelly

Zimmerman and Lisa Losse; Lisa Losse, Jo Zimmerman and Paul Frauendienst, residents; and Kelly Zimmerman, via Zoom, expressed concerns about the issuance of the liquor license. They cited: intoxicated people, road access and maintenance, private easements used for commercial access, safety, lease effective as of May 2026, site plan process has not been completed, access on public lands, increased traffic, and effect on residents.

Jeffrey Boldt, counsel for the applicant, explained a shuttle service will be provided. He said the issues raised are planning-related, and the hearing only concerns the issuance of the liquor license.

Hearing no further PUBLIC COMMENT, Chairman Malm closed the hearing.
