Justin Arnold, Planning, said Steil Surveying Services, LLC, on behalf of G & G Enterprises of Wyoming, LLC, submitted an administrative plat application for Cheyenne Pass, 2nd Filing, situated in a portion of Sect 11, T14N, R70W, 6th PM, Laramie County, WY. He said the subject property lies at 415 Lynx Ln, and the application combines both parcels, creating a 6.92-acre lot for residential use and correcting a problem with setbacks on a residence currently being built.
