SUBJECT: Resolution Acknowledging Receipt of and Accepting the West Crow Creek Greenway Plan

Dear Laramie County Board of Commissioners:

The Cheyenne Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) respectfully submits for your review and consideration the attached resolution acknowledging receipt and acceptance of the *West Crow Creek Greenway Corridor Study* prepared by Ayres Consulting.

This study was programmed in the MPO's FY 2023–2024 Unified Planning Work Program to evaluate opportunities along the West Crow Creek corridor related to multi-use trail connectivity, safety, access, and long-term corridor coordination. West Crow Creek represents an important natural feature within the Cheyenne urban area and has seen increasing interest as both a recreational asset and potential active transportation connection.

The study documents existing conditions, identifies planning-level opportunities, and provides conceptual recommendations intended to guide future coordination among the City of Cheyenne, Laramie County, and other partners as development and infrastructure projects occur over time. The work was completed with stakeholder coordination and public engagement consistent with the MPO's Public Participation Plan.

Acceptance of this resolution recognizes the study as a planning and reference document only. The study does not authorize funding, construction, land-use decisions, or regulatory action, but may be used to inform future planning efforts, grant applications, and corridor discussions as opportunities arise.

We appreciate your continued coordination and partnership in regional planning efforts.
