Attention: This email message is from an external(non-County) email address. Please exercise caution and/or verify authenticity before opening the email/attachments/links from an email you aren't expecting.

Hello, I live in the Table Mountain community. I implore all county officials to actually come and drive the proposed route, especially after drinking 2 alcoholic beverages.

I understand that currently they have not completed their food handlers certification.

I understand that this is just the liquor license review.

However, we need you to understand that the 700 cars that county road 109 aka Gilchrist Rd sees, of that, maybe 50 cars actually turn off Valley View, of that maybe 20 turn onto Crow Creek, down to 10 cars on Valley View, down to 1 maybe 2 onto a two tire track called Brush Creek. From there you get onto BLM land. Still a 2 tire track, to make it 20-24 feet across from Valley View for the road statute, some of which is privately owned, Bit O Wyo will need to tear down mountains and hills, trees and bushes, tear up the creek, as plenty of areas are less than 20 feet, and a cliff on one side a mountain on the other.

A huge threat is wildfires. As drunk smokers don't always extinguish, as others also shoot off fireworks.
