160816 00 The Laramie County Commissioners met in regular session Tuesday, August 16, 2016 at 3:30 p.m. Those in attendance were Commissioner K.N. Buck Holmes, Chairman; Commissioner Linda Heath; Vice Chairman; Commissioner Amber Ash; Commissioner Troy Thompson; Commissioner Ron Kailey; County Attorney Mark Voss and Deputy County Clerk Rhonda Bush.

- **01** Commissioner Thompson moved to approve the Minutes of Proceedings for August 2, 2016. Commissioner Heath seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
- O2 Commissioner Thompson moved to approve the ratification of a resolution to submit a grant application to the Cheyenne Community Public Recreation District on behalf of the Laramie County Recreation Planning and Advisory Board for funding in the amount of \$50,000 to be used towards purchasing playground equipment for Clear Creek Park. Commissioner Kailey seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. The resolution is filed in central files with the County Clerk.
- O3 Commissioner Thompson moved to approve five salary agreements between Laramie County and University of Wyoming beginning July 1, 2016 and ending June 30, 2017 for the total amount of \$171,841. Commissioner Kailey seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. The agreements are filed in central files with the County Clerk.
- O4 Commissioner Thompson moved to approve Amendment Number One to the Agreement (150407-21) between Laramie County and the State of Wyoming, Office of the Governor, for the Microsoft (Project Nephogram) Governor's Data Center Recruitment Fund Project. The Amendment is to extend the construction service completion date from June 30, 2016 to December 31, 2017 and to extend the Agreement expiration date to June 30, 2020. Commissioner Kailey seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. After obtaining all signatures, the amendment is to be filed in central files with the County Clerk.
- **05** Commissioner Thompson moved to approve an Economic Development Services Agreement between Laramie County and Cheyenne LEADS in the

Sprinkler Upgrade to MRG-11229 La. Ball Field Park to bring the total project amount to \$34,000. Commissioner Kailey seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. - 18 Commissioner Thompson moved to approve a resolution authorizing acceptance of an agreement (s) with the Federal Aviation Administration to fund the Cheyenne Regional Airport Project described as "Construct Apron Commercial Terminal Apron" not to exceed \$5,000,000. Commissioner Heath seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. The resolution is filed in central files with the County Clerk.
- 19 Commissioner Ash moved to postpone a Zone Change for a portion of the NW1/4, Section 17, T.14N., R.66W., of the 6th P.M., Laramie County, Wyoming until September 6, 2016. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
- 20 Commissioner Ash moved to postpone a Subdivision Permit and Plat for Highlands Park Ranch, located in a portion of the NW1/4, Section 17, T.14N., R.66W., of the 6th P.M., Laramie County, Wyoming, until September 6, 2016.
- 21 Nathan Groh, Black Hills Power, presented a request for a Board Approval for BHE Met Towers, situated on the King Ranch in a portion of the SE1/4 Section 4, T.13N., R.68W.and a portion of the NW1/2 Section 13, T.13N., R.68W., of the 6th P.M., Laramie County, Wyoming. The purpose of this request is to place two meteorological towers for assessment of wind resource on the property. Chairman Holmes opened the hearing for PUBLIC COMMENT. Hearing no PUBLIC COMMENT, Chairman Holmes closed the hearing. Commissioner Heath moved to grant Board Approval for BHE Met Towers with no conditions and to adopt the findings of fact a and b of the staff report. Commissioner Ash seconded the motion. The resolution is recorded in the Recording Department.
- 22 Pepper McClenahan, Planning, presented a request for a Board Approval for

Toilets on the Go located at Schrader Addition: Tract 1, Laramie County, Wyoming. The application is to permit Toilets on the Go onsite use for limited commercial operations, with the application to run concurrently with a Site Plan to address and mitigate impacts. Ms. McClenahan stated there has been a lot of negative comment regarding this request. Leonardo Ramirez, applicant, said he went through a realtor to lease the property and was not informed of the zoning regulations. Don Schrader, owner of the property, said Mr. Ramirez is a clean operator and doing a good job. Chairman Holmes opened the hearing for PUBLIC COMMENT. Arlene Holomon, Larry Friederich, Jason Lindsay, Charles Shelby, and other citizens spoke against the application for the following reasons: eyesore, wrong location, potential contamination of water, and increase of rodents. Gabriel Pina, 1603 Capitol Avenue, said he represents small business growth, and Mr. Ramirez is a member in good standing. Angie Cruz, 3437 East 12th, said the units are pumped out on site and suggested screening to help satisfy the opposition. Hearing no further PUBLIC COMMENT. Chairman Holmes closed the hearing. Commissioner Thompson moved to continue the discussion on September 6, 2016. Commissioner Ash seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
