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Sentinel Real Estate Scope



- n United States Air Force (USAF) seeks the following interests in real property:
 - n Temporary construction easements
 - New permanent easements for utility corridors
 - n Fee acquisitions for tower sites



Real Estate Acquisition Process



- n Northrop Grumman (NG) Design Site Surveys
 - n Bechtel is currently conducting site surveys
 - n Contacting landowners by phone or email to notify they will access property through Air Force owned easements
 - Malking the site with handheld equipment to confirm existing Air Force line locations
- n Due Diligence Research for Real Estate Acquisition
 - United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) has begun title work, and will soon start appraisals and legal surveys
 - Appraisers and surveyors hired by USACE may begin contacting landowners starting in November
 - n In most cases USACE will develop legal descriptions remotely with few exceptions



Real Estate Acquisition Process Cont...



- n Negotiations (plan to start in early 2023)
 - n USACE will deliver an initial "Offer to Sell" to landowners
 - n Landowners can obtain their own appraisal for the interest being requested on their property
- n The USAF desires to work with landowners in a timely manner with a goal to begin utility corridor construction activities in Fall-2024



Authority to Purchase Property



- September, 2021 the (USAF) submitted a request to Congress to acquire sufficient interest in property to purchase a utility right-of-way, temporary construction easements, and tower sites to support Sentinel Weapons System at FE Warren AFB
- n The draft National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for Fiscal Year 23 contains the USAF request
- uSAF and its agent (USACE) only has authority to negotiate and acquire property approved in the NDAA
