**ENTITLED: "A RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING RECEIPT OF AND  
ACCEPTING  
THE "SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL (SS4A)  
COMPREHENSIVE SAFETY ACTION PLAN"  
PREPARED BY FELSBURG HOLT AND ULLEVIG FOR  
THE CHEYENNE METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION."**

**WHEREAS**, the Cheyenne Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) had programmed in its FY '24 and '25 Unified Planning Work Program the development of a Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Comprehensive Safety Action Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the SS4A Comprehensive Safety Action Plan is to identify transportation safety concerns, analyze crash trends and contributing factors, and develop strategies to reduce roadway fatalities and serious injuries within the Cheyenne urbanized area; and

**WHEREAS**, roadway safety is a critical concern for the Cheyenne community, including motorists, pedestrians, bicyclists, transit users, freight operators, and all users of the transportation system; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cheyenne MPO retained Felsburg Holt and Ullevig (FHU) to prepare the SS4A Comprehensive Safety Action Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the SS4A Comprehensive Safety Action Plan was developed through a comprehensive public and stakeholder engagement process that included public meetings, online engagement opportunities, coordination with partner agencies, and opportunities for public comment; and

**WHEREAS**, the SS4A Comprehensive Safety Action Plan evaluates existing transportation safety conditions and identifies a High Injury Network, priority safety emphasis areas, and recommended strategies and projects intended to improve safety for all roadway users; and

**WHEREAS**, the SS4A Comprehensive Safety Action Plan is intended to serve as a planning and guidance document and does not, by itself, authorize funding, construction, or regulatory action; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cheyenne MPO Technical Advisory Committee and Online Citizens Advisory Committee have reviewed the SS4A Comprehensive Safety Action Plan and recommended its approval.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE LARAMIE COUNTY, WYOMING:**

**THAT**, the Laramie County Governing Body hereby acknowledges receipt of and approves the “Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Comprehensive Safety Action Plan” dated June, 2026 prepared by Felsburg Holt and Ullevig.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Plan may be used as a guiding and planning document to inform future safety coordination efforts, grant applications, transportation planning activities, project prioritization, and potential implementation activities intended to improve transportation safety within the Cheyenne MPO planning area.
