When the trial was scheduled for March 2003, Ms. Huylar was subpoenaed and a ticket purchased for her flight to North Dakota. The defendant signed a written plea agreement, the trial was canceled, and then the defendant refused to enter his guilty plea at the sentencing hearing held July 14, 2003. Although subpoenaed again for the December trial, Ms. Huylar encountered some childcare problems and did not fly to North Dakota. (Transcript, pages 38-42.) Ramsey objected to Huylar testifying by telephone, but then offered the videotape interview into evidence during the testimony of his own expert. (Transcript, pages 297-298.)
