SUBJECT: Road Petition 415

Road petition represents a request to vacate a portion of the original alignment of Road 149, for the purpose of realignment.

Road 149 located in close proximity to County Road 227 is being adjusted to remove a fairly radical curve from the highway system. The new design and construction when completed will leave remnants outside the new alignment. This vacation will allow those remnants to come under the ownership of the adjacent landowners.

It is my recommendation to vacate these remnants as described by survey in the original petition. If you accept that recommendation, you should establish a public hearing on August 16, 2005 to hear and all claims for damages.
