The Laramie County Sheriff's Department is requesting equipment to help us respond to all events in our community that are classified as hazardous, violent, turbulent and/or terroristic. We are requesting "ready bags" and riot gear to include gas masks for our deputies.

A ready bag is a mobile bag that can be equipped with critical medical supplies, extra ammunition, tools and gear to help an officer/deputy survive and to protect life during critical events, to include; active shooter response, terrorist incidents, weapons of mass destruction, or natural disasters. Many law enforcement officers set up ready, or bail out, bags for response to inprogress violent crimes.

We are also requesting riot gear to include gas masks, as the current gear we have is outdated and not in compliance with current standards. In the last year to year and a half, the LCSO has had to prepare for potential riot situations within Laramie County. The LCSO was requested by the Wyoming Highway Patrol on two occasions to prepare for and assist with potential

riot situations at the Wyoming State Capitol. Additionally, the Sheriff's Department has had to prepare for the potential for riots within Laramie County in the aftermath of the George Floyd event. Unfortunately, several cases or events may require riot gear within our community and aiding the State of Wyoming. The Laramie County THIRA is an evolving document that examines our core capabilities and risks or gaps that we face in our mitigation, prevention, response, and recovery operations. The capabilities of "On Scene Security, Protection, & Law <u>Enforcement and "Interdiction & Disruption" are critical to our request for riot gear and ready bags. Our officers need to be able</u>

to deploy within the community or as requested to delay, divert intercept and halt threats and hazards. Without proper equipment, this becomes a dangerous situation for our law enforcement and innocent bystanders.

In the event of a "major" riot or active shooter type event within Laramie County the Sheriff's Office would need the requested riot gear to include, but not limited to, shields, chin guards, gas masks, batons, knee & elbow pads, helmets and gas masks. In providing ready bags to Deputies would offer the opportunities for a more rapid response to threats and hazards, reduce vulnerability, and increase resilience. Some of the benefits associated with providing ready bags to officers would be:

Prevention: Prevent, avoid, or stop an imminent, threatened, or actual attack or act of terrorism

Protection: Protect our citizens, residents, visitors, and assets against the greatest threats and hazards

Mitigation: Reduce the loss of life and property

Other:

Response: Respond quickly to save lives, protect property and the environment, and meet basic human needs in the aftermath of an incident.

15. All projects under this grant must have a nexus to terrorism. Please describe how your project relates to acts of terrorism.

In the event of a terrorist attack within Laramie County, the Sheriff's Department would respond to that event. A terror attack could include attacks on railroads, the State Capitol, WAFB, and other high-risk targets such as CFD. The targets and events could potentially expose responders to chemical, toxic, and nuclear substances not to mention violence. Proper equipment is necessary for our deputies to respond to a terror attack in Laramie County. The requested equipment would help us facilitate a safe response to these events.

16. Provide justification on how the project will be maintained, supported, and sustained.

The receiving Deputy would, individually maintain each ready go-bag. The Department would supply a list of items that should be included and maintained in the ready bag to include, medical supplies, extra ammunition and gear. The riot gear to include, but not limited to (shields, helmets, shin guards, elbow pads, knee pads, batons, baton ring, holders along with gas masks) will be purchased and maintained by the department.

After we have purchased the requested equipment, the Sheriff's Department will maintain control of the equipment, maintain the equipment, and have it at the ready for our deputies in the event of a riot, terror attack, and or a mass casualty event. The department will be responsible for all costs associated with lost or damaged items.

We are requesting equipment for our Laramie County Sheriff's Department for proper and safe response to suspected violent acts such as terrorism, riots, and hostage situations. This request is comprised of the following:

- 1. Responder Bags-a mobile bag that can be equipped with critical supplies such as medical, ammunition, tools and gear to help a deputy survive and protect life during critical events. We are requesting the purchase of 55 bags for all patrol deputies at the Laramie County Sheriff's Department. Each bag is \$19.99 for a total of \$1,099.45.
- a. This price estimate is based off an Amazon Listing for a SOG Responder Bag, 11.5 liter (copy attached).

- b. AEL 01ZP-00-GBAG Bag, Ensemble Gear Storage &/or \$19GN-00-BGPK.
- 2. Riot gear for fifty-five patrol deputies at the Laramie County Sheriff's Department to include shields, helmets, shin guards, knee and elbow pads, baton, baton ring and holders. We anticipate a cost of around \$650.00 per deputy for a total cost of \$35,750.
- a. Shields \$300, Helmet \$150, Shin Guard \$60, Elbow Pads \$20, Knee Pads \$27, Baton \$27, Baton Ring \$10 and holder \$8 and up to \$48 for additional items as needed per deputy.
