RESOLUTION APPROVING AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN NONPROFIT GRANT FUNDING IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,431,116.74
WHEREAS, on or about May 17, 2021, Laramie County received \$19,326,709.00 of funding from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA); and
WHEREAS, ARPA established the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund and

the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (SLFRF); and

WHEREAS, effective April 1, 2022, the Secretary of the Treasury adopted the final rule implementing the SLFRF program, found at 31 C.F.R. Part 35; and

WHEREAS, the final rule implementing the SLFRF allows, among other things, the expenditure of ARPA funds to mitigate the negative public health and economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, including the support of nonprofits; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Laramie County Commissioners elected to utilize \$2,400,000.00 of SLFRF funds to establish a grant program for local 501(c)(3) nonprofit entities that were negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, Laramie County encouraged local 501(c)(3) nonprofit entities to apply for the available grant funding; and

WHEREAS, Laramie County received forty-eight (48) applications from local nonprofit entities requesting a total combined amount of \$5,514,627.47; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Laramie County Commissioners reviewed each application to ensure compliance with applicable law and regulation and approved funding in a total combined amount of \$2,431,116.74; and

WHEREAS, attached hereto as "Exhibit 1" is a comprehensive description of the total funding approved by the Board of Laramie County Commissioners.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that, the Board of Laramie County Commissioners hereby approves total combined funding for qualified 501(c)(3) nonprofit entities in an amount not to exceed \$2,431,116.74 in conformance with "Exhibit 1."
