## Market Performance "Our First 3-Months"

The New Flight has "Ramped-Up" Faster Than Anticipated

- Flight Loads Have Already Hit Targets (Over 4800 passengers using the new service)
- Future Passenger Bookings are Solid Above Previous Months
- Considering a Winter Start and Not Having Practical Air Service in nearly 2 Years – the Market is Showing Strong Signs of Success but...
- Better Connections Need to be Possible
- There're Still Significant Portions of the Market That Can Be Captured



## Market Performance "Our First 3-Months"

#### 57% Local Traffic

 Should be Close to 20% Local Traffic – 37% Above Average

#### 6% Market Retention – 4% Above Average

- Higher Than Expected for New Service with Only 1 Flight Per Day
- Good Indicator that Local Travelers are Willing to use New Cheyenne Airport

Significant Opportunity to Gain Connecting Traffic and Take Additional Market Share



## Market Performance "Our First 3-Months"

One Flight Per Day is a Good Start But Additional Flight Frequencies Are Better:

- Makes it More Viable to Travelers and the Long-Term Success of Air Service in Cheyenne.
- Airline Sees that the Market Has Performed Above Their Expectations Enough to be Justify Adding a Second Flight.



## New Summer Travel Flight Schedule with Second Flight

- Seasonal Additional Flights (May 4, 2019 through September 3, 2019)
  - Covers Our Peak-Summer Travel Season
- Airline Commitment to Stay Through the Contract Period (Early November)
- Strategic for the Future Growth of Air Service
  - A Second Flight is Critical to Demonstrating the Cheyenne Market to Airlines and Future Routes



### Benefits of a Second Flight

#### COST

 Zero Additional Cost Above the Annual Minimum Revenue Guarantee (MRG) Contract

#### BENEFIT

- Ability to Gain Additional Connections
  - Same -Day Business Travel
- Doubles Available Seats
- Additional Visitors
- Additional Full-Time Jobs
- Operational Redundancy



## New Summer Flight Times – The New Second Flight

#### Outbound:

- Departs Cheyenne just before 6 AM
- Arrives Dallas-Fort Worth at 9 AM
- \*Catches 10AM Dallas-Fort Worth Bank and All Flights After

#### Return:

 Catches 9PM Dallas-Fort Worth Bank and All Flights Before

Departs Dallas-Fort Worth at 10:40 PM


Arrives Cheyenne at 11:55 PM

\*Current Flight Remains as Scheduled

Second Flight Enables 50 More Connections\* Including:

 Phoenix, Los Angeles, Seattle, San Diego, Las Vegas, Portland, Minneapolis/St. Paul, San Jose, Cancun, Cabo San Lucas

More Available Connections:

Dallas-Fort Worth has the 2<sup>nd</sup> Most Destinations of any Airport Nationwide\*

- 2.4 Times More than Phoenix
- 2.3 Times More than Salt Lake
- 41% More than Denver

Large Local Market + Huge Connections = More Passengers
