**RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING JULY 10, 2019 WYOMING STATEHOOD DAY**

**WHEREAS**, the County wishes to join the State of Wyoming and the City of Cheyenne in recognizing Wyoming Statehood Day: and

**WHEREAS**, Laramie County wishes to recognize the restoration of Wyoming's Capitol and Capitol Square;

**WHEREAS**, President William Henry Harrison, on July 10, 1890, signed the bill admitting Wyoming to the Union as the 44<sup>th</sup> State;

**WHEREAS**, the State of Wyoming has invested considerable resources to remodel and upgrade the State Capitol and associated structures;

**WHEREAS**, in celebration of the completion of the significant restoration and upgrade of the Capitol and Capitol Square, and on the anniversary of Wyoming becoming a State, Laramie County resolves as follows;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Laramie County Commissioners that County employees are granted one-half day off work commencing at noon on July 10, 2019 to join the festivities occurring that day.
