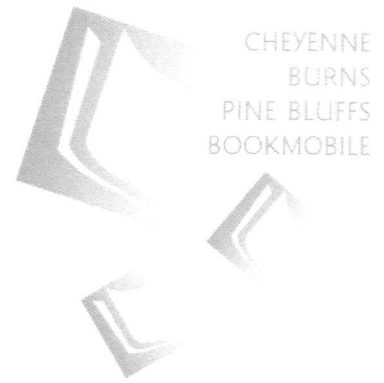

RE: Consideration of Laramie County Library System Board Appointments  
FY20

Library board members Khale Lenhart and Kevin Guille are completing their second terms on the Laramie County Library System (LCLS) Board of Directors as of June 30, 2019. As per Wyoming statute § 18-7-103(b) "A director may be appointed for two (2) consecutive terms and shall not be eligible for reappointment until two (2) years after the second term expires." In addition, LCLS board member Joe Bonds resigned in January 2019. Thus there are two vacant LCLS board positions as of July 1, 2019. There is one appointment needed to complete the last year of Mr. Bond's term that expires June 30, 2020.

Attached you will find the Laramie County Board Application Forms, letters of interest and resumes for the six individuals who have expressed interest in being appointed to the LCLS Board of Directors. It is an outstanding group of highly qualified citizens.

The Board had a difficult time making decisions among these candidates in creating a prioritized list to forward to you in recommendation, as all have good qualities and backgrounds that would be beneficial on a board. The recommended applicants will bring qualities to the board that will be needed in the coming three years and beyond. Expertise in finance, connections to the military and small business, and expertise in public communications will be important as the library plans strategically for the anticipated growth in our community.
