**LARAMIE COUNTY
COMPENSATION FOR ELECTION JUDGES,
AND CANVASSING BOARD MEMBERS**

WHEREAS, Wyoming State Statute 22-8-116 provides judges of election shall be compensated for services at a rate to be determined by the board of county commissioners. The rate shall be not less than the state minimum wage. Compensation shall begin one (1) hour before a member assumes his duties. If a flat rate is paid, said sum shall not be less than the state hourly minimum wage multiplied by the number of hours the polls are open plus one (1) hour; AND

WHEREAS, Wyoming State Statute 22-16-101 provides canvassing board members shall receive the same compensation as election judges;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED: that the following rates of compensation shall be established:

Election Judge Coordinator	\$225 flat rate per election
Election Judge	\$200 flat rate per election
Election Judge Part-time	\$100 flat rate per election
Canvassing Board Member	\$200 flat rate per election
Attending training school(s)	\$ 35

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any county employee appointed by the county clerk to work for an election and assigned to work to provide election support shall only receive their regular county compensation and any overtime if not exempt by FLSA.
