1.0—ADDITIONAL DEFINITIONS

In addition to the definitions provided in the Master Agreement, the following definitions apply to this Agreement:

"Case" means a failure of the Software or Online Services to operate according to the Documentation where such failure substantially impacts operational or functional performance.

"Customer" means Managing Customer and Authorized Entity.

"Deploy", "Deployed" and "Deployment" mean to redistribute and install the Products and related Authorization Codes within Customer's organization(s).

"Fee" means the fee set forth in the Quotation.

"Maintenance" means Tier 2 Support, Product updates, and Product patches provided to Managing Customer during the Term of Agreement.

"Master Agreement" means the applicable master agreement for Esri Products incorporated by this reference that is (i) found at <https://www.esri.com/en-us/legal/terms/full-master-agreement> and available in the installation process requiring acceptance by electronic acknowledgment or (ii) a signed Esri master agreement or license agreement that supersedes such electronically acknowledged master agreement.

"Product(s)" means the products identified in Table A—List of Products and any updates to the list Esri provides in writing.

"Quotation" means the offer letter and quotation provided separately to Managing Customer.

"Technical Support" means the technical assistance for attempting resolution of a reported Case through error correction, patches, hot fixes, workarounds, replacement deliveries, or any other type of Product corrections or modifications.

"Tier 1 Help Desk" means Managing Customer's point of contact(s) to provide all Tier 1 Support within Customer's organization(s).

"Tier 1 Support" means the Technical Support provided by the Tier 1 Help Desk.

"Tier 2 Support" means the Esri Technical Support provided to the Tier 1 Help Desk when a Case cannot be resolved through Tier 1 Support.

2.0—ADDITIONAL GRANT OF LICENSE

2.1 Grant of License. Subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, Esri grants to Customer a personal, nonexclusive, nontransferable license solely to use, copy and Deploy quantities of the Products listed in Table A—List of Products for the Term of Agreement (i) for the applicable Fee and (ii) in accordance with the Master Agreement. Additionally, Esri grants to Managing Customer the right to Deploy for Customer's internal use, provided prior to Deploying to an Authorized Entity, Esri receives a signed copy of the Authorized Entity Acknowledgment Statement.

2.2 Consultant Access. Esri grants Customer the right to permit Customer's consultants or contractors to use the Products exclusively for Customer's benefit. Customer will be solely responsible for compliance by consultants and contractors with this Agreement and will ensure that the consultant or contractor discontinues use of Products upon completion of work for Customer. Access to or use of Products by consultants or contractors not exclusively for Customer's benefit is prohibited. Customer may not permit its consultants or contractors to install Software or Data on consultant, contractor, or third-party computers or remove Software or Data from Managing Customer locations, except for the purpose of hosting the Software or Data on Contractor servers for the benefit of Customer.

3.0—TERM, TERMINATION, AND EXPIRATION

3.1 Term. This Agreement and all licenses hereunder will commence on the Effective Date and continue for the duration identified in the Term of Agreement, unless this Agreement is terminated earlier as provided herein. Customer is only authorized to use Products during the Term of Agreement. For an Agreement with a limited term, Esri does not grant Customer an indefinite or a perpetual license to Products.

3.2 No Use upon Agreement Expiration or Termination. All Product licenses, all Maintenance, and Esri User Conference registrations terminate upon expiration or termination of this Agreement.

3.3 Termination for a Material Breach. Either party may terminate this Agreement for a material breach by the other party. The breaching party

will have thirty (30) days from the date of written notice to cure any material breach.

3.4 Termination for Lack of Funds. For an Agreement with government or government-owned entities, either party may terminate this Agreement before any subsequent year if Managing Customer is unable to secure funding through the legislative or governing body's approval process.

3.5 Follow-on Term. If the parties enter into another agreement substantially similar to this Agreement for an additional term, the effective date of the follow-on agreement will be the day after the expiration date of this Agreement.

3.6 Termination of an Individual Authorized Entity. Esri may terminate the license rights of a particular Authorized Entity for material breach without terminating this Agreement with Managing Customer. The breaching Authorized Entity will be given a period of thirty (30) days from the date of written notice to cure any material breach. Upon the termination of an Authorized Entity, all Products Deployed to the Authorized Entity will also terminate. Managing Customer shall reasonably cooperate with Esri in termination of an Authorized Entity for material breach of this Agreement, including enforcement of the Agreement with respect to such Authorized Entity. There will be no reduction in the Fee if an Authorized Entity's rights are terminated. The terminated Authorized Entity will have no further access to any benefits, entitlements, rights, or other items included in or otherwise related to this Agreement.

3.7 Termination by Authorized Entity. If an Authorized Entity no longer desires to participate in this Agreement, the Authorized Entity may terminate; however, there will be no decrease in the Fee as a result.

4.0—PRODUCT UPDATES

4.1 Future Updates. Esri reserves the right to update the list of Products in Table A—List of Products by providing written notice to Managing Customer. Customer may continue to use all Products that have been Deployed, but support and upgrades for deleted items may not be available. As new Products are incorporated into the standard program, they will be offered to Managing Customer via written notice for incorporation into the Products schedule at no

additional charge. Customer's use of new or updated Products requires Customer to adhere to applicable additional or revised terms and conditions in the Master Agreement.

4.2 Product Life Cycle. During the Term of Agreement, some Products may be retired or may no longer be available to Deploy in the identified quantities. Maintenance will be subject to the individual Product Life Cycle Support Status and Product Life Cycle Support Policy, which can be found at <https://support.esri.com/en/other-resources/product-life-cycle>. Updates for Products in the mature and retired phases may not be available. Customer may continue to use Products already Deployed, but Managing Customer will not be able to Deploy retired Products.

5.0—MAINTENANCE

The Fee includes standard maintenance benefits during the Term of Agreement as specified in the most current applicable Esri Maintenance and Support Program document (found at <https://www.esri.com/en-us/legal/terms/maintenance>). At Esri's sole discretion, Esri may make patches, hot fixes, or updates available for download. No Software other than the defined Products will receive Maintenance. Customer may acquire maintenance for other Software outside this Agreement.

a. Tier 1 Support

1. Managing Customer will provide Tier 1 Support through the Tier 1 Help Desk to all Customer's authorized users.
2. The Tier 1 Help Desk will be fully trained in the Products.
3. At a minimum, Tier 1 Support will include those activities that assist the user in resolving how-to and operational questions as well as questions on installation and troubleshooting procedures.
4. The Tier 1 Help Desk will be the initial point of contact for all questions and reporting of a Case. The Tier 1 Help Desk will obtain a full description of each reported Case and the system configuration from the user. This may include obtaining any customizations, code samples, or data involved in the Case.

5. If the Tier 1 Help Desk cannot resolve the Case, an authorized Tier 1 Help Desk individual may contact Tier 2 Support. The Tier 1 Help Desk will provide support in such a way as to minimize repeat calls and make solutions to problems available to Customer's organization.
6. Tier 1 Help Desk individuals are the only individuals authorized to contact Tier 2 Support. Managing Customer may change the Tier 1 Help Desk individuals by written notice to Esri.

b. Tier 2 Support

1. Tier 2 Support will log the calls received from Tier 1 Help Desk.
2. Tier 2 Support will review all information collected by and received from the Tier 1 Help Desk including preliminary documented troubleshooting provided by the Tier 1 Help Desk when Tier 2 Support is required.
3. Tier 2 Support may request that Tier 1 Help Desk individuals provide verification of information, additional information, or answers to additional questions to supplement any preliminary information gathering or troubleshooting performed by Tier 1 Help Desk.
4. Tier 2 Support will attempt to resolve the Case submitted by Tier 1 Help Desk.
5. When the Case is resolved, Tier 2 Support will communicate the information to Tier 1 Help Desk, and Tier 1 Help Desk will disseminate the resolution to the user(s).

6.0—ENDORSEMENT AND PUBLICITY

This Agreement will not be construed or interpreted as an exclusive dealings agreement or Customer's endorsement of Products. Either party may publicize the existence of this Agreement.

7.0—ADMINISTRATIVE REQUIREMENTS

7.1 OEM Licenses. Under Esri's OEM or Solution OEM programs, OEM partners are authorized to embed or bundle portions of Esri products and services with their application or service. OEM partners' business model, licensing terms and conditions, and pricing are independent of this

Agreement. Customer will not seek any discount from the OEM partner or Esri based on the availability of Products under this Agreement. Customer will not decouple Esri products or services from the OEM partners' application or service.

7.2 Annual Report of Deployments. At each anniversary date and ninety (90) calendar days prior to the expiration of this Agreement, Managing Customer will provide Esri with a written report detailing all Deployments. Upon request, Customer will provide records sufficient to verify the accuracy of the annual report.

8.0—ORDERING, ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES, DELIVERY, AND DEPLOYMENT

8.1 Orders, Delivery, and Deployment

- a. Upon the Effective Date, Esri will invoice Managing Customer and provide Authorization Codes to activate the nondestructive copy protection program that enables Managing Customer to download, operate, or allow access to the Products. If this is a multi-year Agreement, Esri may invoice the Fee up to thirty (30) calendar days before the annual anniversary date for each year.
- b. Undisputed invoices will be due and payable within thirty (30) calendar days from the date of invoice. Esri reserves the right to suspend Customer's access to and use of Products if Managing Customer fails to pay any undisputed amount owed on or before its due date. Esri may charge Managing Customer interest at a monthly rate equal to the lesser of one percent (1.0%) per month or the maximum rate permitted by applicable law on any overdue fees plus all expenses of collection for any overdue balance that remains unpaid ten (10) days after Esri has notified Managing Customer of the past-due balance.
- c. Esri's federal ID number is 95-2775-732.
- d. If requested, Esri will ship backup media to the ship-to address identified on the Ordering Document, FOB Destination, with shipping charges prepaid. Managing Customer acknowledges that should sales or use taxes become due as a result of any shipments of tangible media, Esri has a right to invoice and Managing Customer will pay any such sales or

use tax associated with the receipt of tangible media.

8.2 Order Requirements. Esri does not require Managing Customer to issue a purchase order. Managing Customer may submit a purchase order in accordance with its own process requirements, provided that if Managing Customer issues a purchase order, Managing Customer will submit its initial purchase order on the Effective Date. If this is a multi-year Agreement, Managing Customer will submit subsequent purchase orders to Esri at least thirty (30) calendar days before the annual anniversary date for each year.

- a. All orders pertaining to this Agreement will be processed through Managing Customer's centralized point of contact.
- b. The following information will be included in each Ordering Document:
 - (1) Managing Customer name; Esri customer number, if known; and bill-to and ship-to addresses
 - (2) Order number
 - (3) Applicable annual payment due

9.0—MERGERS, ACQUISITIONS, OR DIVESTITURES

If Customer is a commercial entity, Customer will notify Esri in writing in the event of (i) a consolidation, merger, or reorganization of Customer with or into another corporation or entity; (ii) Customer's acquisition of another entity; or (iii) a transfer or sale of all or part of Customer's organization (subsections i, ii, and iii, collectively referred to as "**Ownership Change**"). There will be no decrease in Fee as a result of any Ownership Change.

- 9.1** If an Ownership Change increases the cumulative program count beyond the maximum level for this Agreement, Esri reserves the right to increase the Fee or terminate this Agreement and the parties will negotiate a new agreement.
- 9.2** If an Ownership Change results in transfer or sale of a portion of Customer's organization, that portion of Customer's organization will uninstall, remove, and destroy or transfer the Products to Customer.

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BY AND BETWEEN
LARAMIE COUNTY, THE CITY OF CHEYENNE, THE CHEYENNE BOARD OF
PUBLIC UTILITIES, THE CHEYENNE/LARAMIE COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH,
AND THE CHEYENNE REGIONAL AIRPORT BOARD
REGARDING THE MANAGEMENT OF THE ESRI ENTERPRISE AGREEMENT**

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter "MOU") is made and entered into by and between Laramie County, Wyoming, 310 West 19th Street, P.O. Box 608, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82003-0608 (hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY"), the City of Cheyenne, 2101 O'Neil Avenue, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82001 (hereinafter referred to as "CITY"), the City of Cheyenne Board of Public Utilities, 2416 Snyder Avenue, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82001 (hereinafter referred to as "BOPU"), the Cheyenne/Laramie County Board of Health, 100 Central Avenue, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82001 (hereinafter referred to as "HEALTH") and the Cheyenne Regional Airport Board, 4020 Airport Parkway West, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82001 (hereinafter referred to as "AIRPORT"). The parties agree as follows:

I. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this MOU is to define the management and coordination strategy in administering the Enterprise Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "EA") by and between the COUNTY and Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc., 380 New York Street, Redlands, California 92373-8100 (hereinafter referred to as "ESRI"). This is a renewal of an existing EA that benefits the members of the Cheyenne and Laramie County Geographical Information System (GIS) Cooperative (hereinafter referred to as "CLCGISC") in coordinating and collaborating on ESRI software licensing and maintenance.

II. EA MANAGEMENT.

A. The COUNTY will serve as the Lead agency for the EA. This includes acting as the contractual agency with ESRI in approval of the EA Terms and Conditions; managing a budget line item for pooling of funds from all agencies participating in the EA; and payment of the annual ESRI EA invoice.

B. The Cheyenne/Laramie County GIS Cooperative Coordinator will be the point of contact with ESRI in managing the EA to include the following items:

1. Act as single point of contact for orders and deliveries of software and redistribution to eligible users. Total backup media will not exceed two (2). Additional back up media is available for purchase by the requesting agency.
2. Provide ESRI with annual report of GIS software installations of software products referenced in the EA.

3. Distribute invoices to the parties to this MOU in an amount agreed to in Paragraph C below. Invoices will be distributed at least sixty (60) days prior to the anniversary date of the EA.

C. The parties to this MOU agree to fund the EA for their proportional share as follows with the EA start date of January 20, 2021, and for each year of the three (3) year EA term:

D. Additional members of the CLCGISC are allowed to participate in the EA and their share of the annual maintenance costs will be determined by the appropriate agency named in this MOU. If the EA is not renewed after this three (3) year term, then ESRI software licensing and maintenance costs will be determined by ESRI and paid by the individual member agencies or appropriate governmental entity.

E. The parties to this MOU will provide an annual report of installed ESRI software within their jurisdiction to the CLCGISC Coordinator thirty (30) days prior to the EA anniversary date. Deployments of software covered by this EA within agencies not named or under the direct guidance of a named party to this MOU must be covered under a separate agreement between this new agency and ESRI.

F. The Tier 1 support center and Tier 2 technical support will consist of the following individuals who are authorized to contact ESRI directly for technical support:

COUNTY GIS Coordinator
CITY GIS Coordinator
BOPU GIS Coordinator
MPO GIS Coordinator

Additional ESRI users requiring technical support will first contact one of these individuals prior to contacting the CLCGISC Coordinator.

G. Four (4) ESRI User Conference complimentary passes will be shared between the named entities in this MOU. Two (2) passes will be designated for use by BOPU each year and if they choose to not use one or both passes then these passes will be made available for use by the remaining entities. Use of these passes will be determined each year by mutual understanding between the parties.

III. GENERAL PROVISIONS.

A. Entire Agreement. This MOU, consisting of seven (7) pages, represents the entire and integrated agreement and understanding between the parties and supersedes all prior negotiations, statements, representations, and agreements, whether written or oral.

B. Assignment. Neither this MOU, nor any rights or obligations hereunder shall be assigned or delegated by a party without the prior written consent of the other party.

C. Modification. This MOU shall be modified only by a written agreement, duly executed by all parties hereto.

D. Invalidity. If any provision of this MOU is held invalid or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, or if the named entities are advised of any such actual or potential invalidity or unenforceability, such holding or advice shall not invalidate or render unenforceable any other provision hereof. It is the express intent of the parties that the provisions of this MOU are fully severable.

E. Applicable Law and Venue. The parties mutually understand and agree this MOU shall be governed by and interpreted pursuant to the laws of the State of Wyoming. If any dispute arises between the parties from or concerning this MOU or the subject matter hereof, any suit or proceeding at law or in equity shall be brought in the District Court of the State of Wyoming, First Judicial District, sitting at Cheyenne, Wyoming. This provision is not intended nor shall it be construed to waive the parties' governmental immunity as provided in this MOU.

F. Contingencies. The parties mutually certify and warrant that no gratuities, kick-backs, or contingency fees were paid in connection with this MOU, nor were any fees, commissions, gifts, or other considerations made contingent upon the award of this MOU.

G. Discrimination. The parties agree they will not discriminate against any person who performs work under the terms and conditions of this MOU because of race, color, gender, creed, handicapping condition, or national origin.

H. ADA Compliance. The parties agree they will not discriminate against a qualified individual with disability, pursuant to a law as set forth in the Americans With Disabilities Act, P.L. 101-336, 42 U.S.C. § 12101, *et seq.*, and/or any properly promulgated rules and regulations relating thereto.

I. Governmental/Sovereign Immunity. The parties do not waive their Governmental/Sovereign Immunity, as provided by any applicable law, including Wyo. Stat. § 1-39-101, *et seq.*, by entering into this MOU. Further, the parties fully retain all immunities and defenses provided by law with regard to any action, whether in tort, contract, or any other theory of law based on this MOU.

J. Indemnification. Each party to this MOU shall be responsible for any liability arising from its own conduct. Neither party agrees to insure, defend, or indemnify the other.

K. Third Parties. The parties do not intend to create in any other individual or entity the status of third party beneficiary, and this MOU shall not be construed so as to create such status. The rights, duties, and obligations contained in this MOU shall operate only between the parties to the MOU and shall inure solely to the benefit of the parties to this MOU.

L. Conflict of Interest. COUNTY, CITY, BOPU, HEALTH and AIRPORT affirm that to their knowledge no employee has any personal beneficial interest whatsoever in the MOU described herein. No staff members of the parties, compensated either partially or wholly with funds from this MOU, shall engage in any conduct or activity which would constitute a conflict of interest relative to this MOU.

M. Force Majeure. The performance of the MOU by either party shall be subject to force majeure including, but not limited to, acts of God, fire, flood, natural disaster, war or threat of war, acts or threats of terrorism, civil disorder, unauthorized strikes, governmental regulation or advisory, recognized health threats as determined by the World Health Organization, the Centers for Disease Control, or local government authority or health agencies (including, but not limited to, the health threats of COVID-19, H1N1, or similar infectious diseases), curtailment of transportation facilities, or other similar occurrence beyond the control of the parties, where any of those factors, circumstances, situations, or conditions or similar ones prevent, dissuade, or unreasonably delay the performance required by this MOU. The MOU may be cancelled by either party, without liability, damages, fees, or penalty, and any unused deposits or amounts paid shall be refunded, for any one or more of the above reasons, by written notice to the other party.

N. Notices. All notices required and permitted under this MOU shall be deemed to have been given, if and when deposited in the U.S. Mail, properly stamped and addressed to the party for whom intended at such parties' address listed herein, or when personally delivered to such party. A party may change its address for notice hereunder by giving written notice to the other party.

O. Compliance with Laws. All parties warrant that they will comply with all applicable laws, regulations, and ordinances, whether federal, state, or local in carrying out the purposes of this MOU.


