Chairman Malm explained the purpose of the special meeting was to discuss and clarify the application process for CARES Act funding for 501(c)3 and 501(c)19 organizations. The meeting was a follow up to the virtual special meeting held on Dec. 23, 2020.

Sandra Newland, Grants, stated that 501(c)3 and 501(c)19 organizations that provided goods and services related to the COVID-19 public health emergency were eligible for the grants. She noted there is now only one application instead of two, and the application clarifies the eligibility requirements. The application deadline is Feb. 1, 5:00 p.m. The application will be posted on the county's website.

Chairman Malm invited participating organizations to submit questions. He said questions on eligibility that could not be answered would be forwarded to the Attorney General to ensure funding is properly done.

Several organizations submitted questions on eligibility of churches and "pass through" organizations that do not provide direct services but support other service-providers. Ms. Newland encouraged organization to contact her for any questions they may have. She also informed organizations they can withdraw a previously submitted application, amend their application, or submit a new one.

Commissioners also offered their contact information to assist organizations.

Commissioners reiterated that \$1.95 million is available to disburse to qualifying organizations that submit an application and they encouraged organizations to apply.

The meeting adjourned at 11:30 a.m.
