

I have had the opportunity for the past seven-years to live and work in Laramie County. I did not expect to stay here as long as I have, but my family and I have grown to love Cheyenne and Laramie County. We enjoy the lifestyle, the people and the opportunities that Wyoming affords. I would like to give back to the community that my family and I enjoy so much. I believe that serving on the Laramie County Planning Commission allows me to do so.

My interest in serving on the Planning Commission stems from a desire to help Laramie County continue to be an economic driver for the region through appropriately applied land use planning methods. As I have reviewed Laramie County's Land Use Regulations (2019) and Laramie County's Comprehensive Plan (2016), I interpret both guiding documents to be for the benefit of Laramie County citizens and their economic, and health and safety.
