Justin Arnold, Planning, said Steil Surveying Services, LLC, on behalf of Steven J Beer, submitted zone change and subdivision permit and plat applications for a parcel in the NW1/4 of Sect 5, T14N, R66W, 6th PM, Laramie County, WY, to be known as the Beer Gardens Subdivision. He said the subject property lies between 1733 Iron Mountain Rd and 1919 Iron Mountain Rd.

Arnold said the applications were submitted to request a zone change from A1 - Agricultural and Rural Residential to AR Agricultural Residential and to subdivide the property into three tracts. Both applications were combined into one staff report for ease of presentation and discussion, with separate motions required.

Arnold said based on evidence provided, staff recommends approval of the zone change with the adoption of findings of fact a and b and approval of the subdivision permit and plat with the adoption of findings of fact c, both approvals with no

conditions.
