Hearing no PUBIC COMMENT, Vice Chairman Heath closed the hearing. Commissioner Kailey asked if were any water issues. Gary Hickman, Environmental Health, stated the minimum lot size for a well on a septic system is five acres, and the minimum size has not caused a lot of issues. Mr. Hickman also noted they have access to a large database on water quality and quantity. Mr. Emmons said based on evidence provided, staff recommend approval.
