Nicholle Watkins gave an update on the Avian Flu Status. The Livestock Board decided not to lift the ban on moving poultry in the State at their May meeting. They will evaluate the status again June 13th. The State Veterinarian will be holding seminars to educate the public on methods to prevent Avian Flu. Most of the Flu cases are in four northern Wyoming Counties. The Livestock Board left the option open to have an emergency meeting in July. Ultimately, the decision will come down to the County. Most likely distancing requirements will be recommended for poultry shows.

Bryce Freeman, Kiwanis Sale committee member, gave an update on the Kiwanis Sale of Champions. It will be held at the Hereford Ranch location again this year. Kiwanis will be cooking steaks and preparing the meal prior to the show.

Pam Freeman, 4-H Livestock Sale Committee member, reported they will have the Virtual On-Line auction available again this year to Buyers. Centennial Auction will be providing the auctioneers again. Coffee, doughnuts, and lunches for buyers will be donated again this year by generous supporters of the 4-H livestock sale.
